- Competent in pipe building and understand hygienic welding principles and procedures

- On occasion, work during unsociable hours and be prepared to work away from home
- Liaise with customer or site employees and represent the Company at all times
- Ensure that Health and Safety guidelines are followed. Be responsible for your own Health and Safety as well as those around you
- Prepared to be trained for new skills or have further training in relevant areas
